Message from the **Executive**

MORE COMMITTED THAN EVER

A major change in the health network occurred on April 1, 2015, when the reforms of the Health and Social Services Minister, Dr. Gaétan Barrette, were put into action. That was the day Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont (HMR) became part of the Centre intégré universitaire de santé et de services sociaux (CIUSSS) de l'Est-de-l'Île-de-Montréal, an integrated university health and social services centre serving east-end Montreal. That being said, **the HMR Foundation is still the Foundation for HMR.** And we now benefit from the outstanding collaboration of the CIUSSS's new President & CEO, Yvan Gendron, along with his team, in the pursuit of our vital mission.

Our commitment to the people served by HMR will not waver. And rightfully so. According to the CIUSSS de l'Est-de-l'Île-de-Montréal, life expectancy for those living in some east-end Montreal neighbourhoods is up to nine years lower than those living in the western part of the island. And needs are only multiplying: emergency room admissions are skyrocketing, cases are getting more serious and the incidence of new cancer cases is greater than the Montreal average. Also, a third of the population suffers from at least one chronic disease.

More than ever, the Foundation needs the unwavering commitment of its donors, the public and everyone who benefits from the high levels of care delivered at HMR. The facilities of this remarkable medical centre need major upgrades if HMR is to respond effectively to the needs of the people it serves. **Through its solid commitment, the Foundation continues to support projects aimed at constantly improving patient care, developing teaching and expanding research.**

In 2015, we remained focused on supporting HMR's strategic directions and better meeting patient needs. 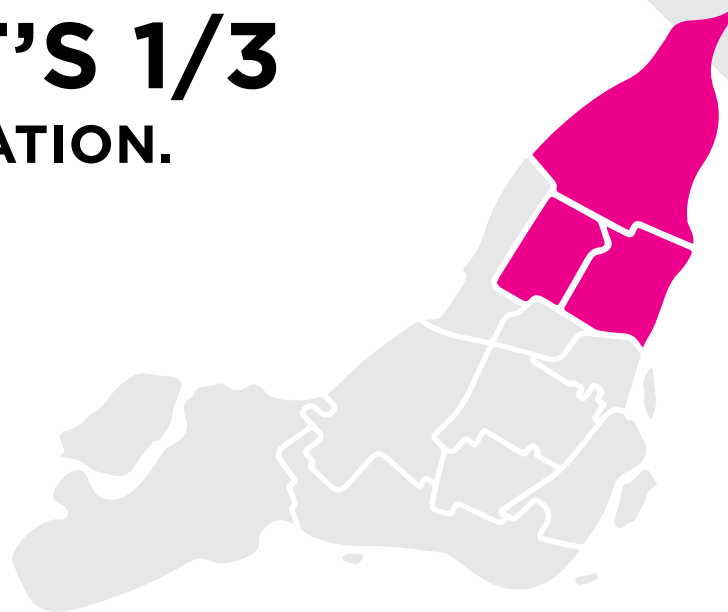

Firmly rooted in Montreal's east end since 1954, Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont (HMR) has passionately pursued its mission—delivering quality healthcare to patients via innovative and collaborative clinical practices combining knowledge sharing, teaching and research.



Growing needs¹:

- An aging population: people 65 and up account for **16.7%** of east-end Montreal's population, versus 15.7% for Montreal in general
- **36%** of the population suffer from at least one chronic illness
- **38%** of the population have at least two lifestyle behaviours linked to the onset of a chronic illness
- **31%** are single-parent families with children aged 17 or under
- **29%** of the area's population are recent immigrants
- The population's average revenue is lower than that of the whole area of Montréal
- Life expectancy for those living in some east-end Montreal neighbourhoods is up to nine years lower than those living in the western part of the island

IMMUNOLOGY-ONCOLOGY

The Immunology-Oncology research focus seeks to better understand the mechanisms that regulate genomic instability, the development of cancers, immune reconstitution and T. lymphocyte response. HMR's excellence in this area has enabled the hospital to build **the largest body of expertise in stem cell transplantation in Quebec**. Furthermore, HMR is home to a Centre of Excellence in Cellular Therapy, where this promising field's top doctors and researchers work side by side.

NEPHROLOGY

The HMR is home to the largest single-site dialysis centre in Quebec. **The centre is the fourth-largest** in the world, coming just behind New York's. HMR's nephrology professionals are renowned for the many research projects they are carrying out in the search for treatments that could cure kidney failure and related illnesses, including diabetes and high blood pressure.

YOUR DONATIONS AT WORK

Many projects are carried out every year thanks to our generous donors. As you peruse the 2015 Annual Report, you will read about the year's accomplishments both big and small.



NEONATAL UNIT

OmniBed Giraffe Carestation, an advanced dome-type incubator for premature babies. It gives members of the care team easy access to preemies in order to safely carry out procedures including central catheter placement, intubation and resuscitation. These procedures would be impossible to perform with a standard incubator.

NEPHROLOGY

Four hemodialysis machines and a mobile water treatment machine: used mainly to purify the blood of patients suffering from kidney failure, these machines have become increasingly necessary as the old ones were outdated and had been used well beyond their useful life. Moreover, with the opening of the new HMR emergency department, the nursing staff needed more machines to keep up with patient needs.

PEDIATRICS

Expansion of the pediatric outpatient unit: The creation of Unit 8CD provided a suitable environment offering greater access to services and enhanced management of pediatric patients from Montreal's east end. Equipment including stretchers, treatment chairs, an examination table, a precision infant scale and a pulse oximeter was purchased to improve the quality of the care children receive (from birth to 17 years of age).

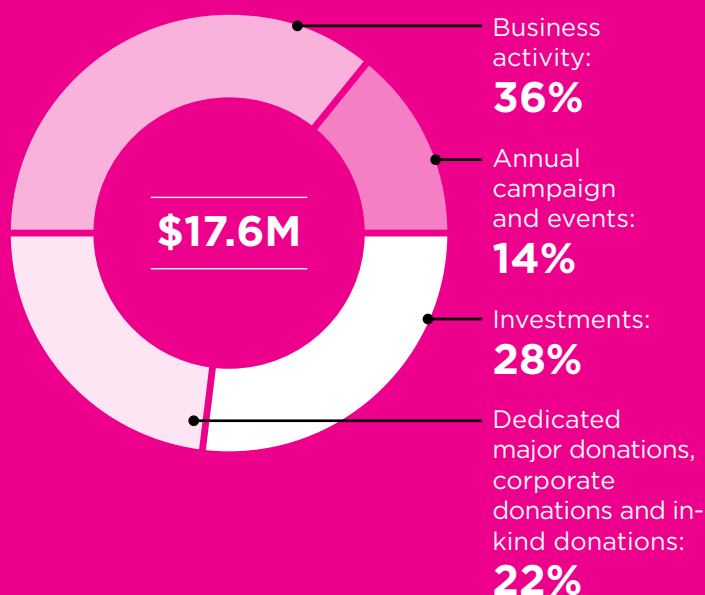

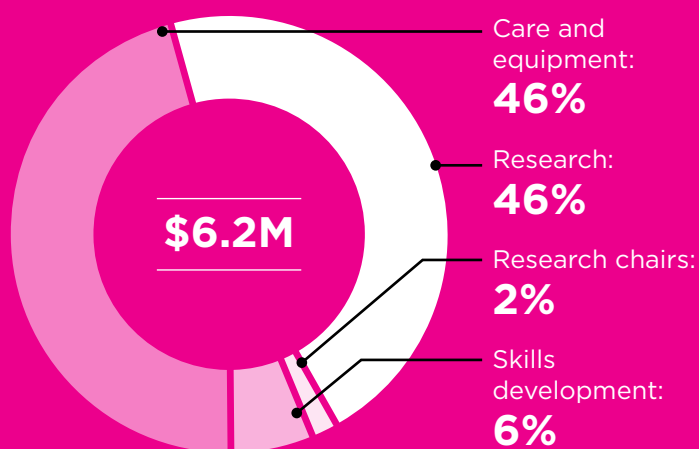
STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL HEALTH

ARGUS® II PROSTHESIS: A MAJOR BREAKTHROUGH IN VISION SCIENCE

In 2015, Hôpital Maisonneuve-Rosemont was selected by medical technology firm SecondSight to become the first medical centre in Quebec to be able to implant the Argus® II Retinal Prosthesis System. The HMR Foundation is proud to have contributed to this major breakthrough in the field of vision science by making the procedure available to the first patient for \$250,000.

Cause for hope, Argus® II represents the technology of the future and opens the door to yet-unseen possibilities. Thanks to a chip implanted in the retina, a miniature video camera mounted on the patient's glasses and small pulses of electricity that create the perception of patterns of light, this prosthesis gives people who are blind a chance to recover some of their sight.

The Argus® II prosthesis allows people suffering from a degenerative eye disease to recognize shapes or large objects, locate people, determine where doorways are, or to follow lines or curbs. This device provides invaluable aid to greatly facilitate daily activities.

ONCOLOGY: UNDERSTANDING DISTRESS BETTER

In 2015, the HMR Foundation helped improve the care provided to patients by supporting advances in nursing research at HMR's Centre of Excellence in Nursing Care (CESI). Since 2006, CESI has been Canada's only centre of excellence in nursing care recognized by Accreditation Canada as a best practice. In collaboration with the Canadian Association of Nurses in Oncology (CANO), the Foundation supported a study on the processes involved in systematically screening for distress in patients diagnosed with blood cancer or breast cancer.

Anyone who knows someone fighting cancer quickly realizes that both the patient and his or her loved ones are forced to make many adjustments to their lives throughout the entire treatment period. Distress, which usually takes the form of anxiety, insomnia, fear and sadness, is a major problem among cancer patients.

In addition to shedding new light on the phenomenon, this study gathered invaluable information on the perception of nurses and patients in what can only be described as a delicate situation. More importantly, the study's findings will be used to better adapt the available resources to the needs expressed by patients.

Improving patient care quality is a central part of the HMR Foundation's priorities.

MORE SCREENINGS, FASTER

In 2015, with help from Fondation J.-Louis Lévesque and Jean Turmel, the HMR Foundation supported the creation of a program to train clinical nurses to screen for diabetic retinopathy.

The program, developed by HMR retinologist and researcher Dr. Marie-Carole Boucher, provides diabetic patients with easier access to high-quality screening for the early signs of diabetic retinopathy. This makes it easier to give affected patients the treatment and care they require.

Thanks to improved training and state-of-the-art equipment, nurses carry out an initial reading of triage results, identify cases that indicate a pathology, and work closely with retinologists to increase the efficiency of the screening process.

This bold and innovative initiative has had nothing but a positive impact on patient care and has helped streamline resource management to better meet the needs of the population, increase the number of patients in care and prevent many cases of blindness.

MEDICINE FOCUSED ON PATIENT NEEDS

The HMR Foundation supported the creation of a teaching clinic at HMR aimed at patients with amyotrophic lateral sclerosis (ALS), also known as Lou Gehrig's disease. The disease progresses rapidly: once diagnosed, patients live less than five years. To date, no effective treatment has been found.

In the past few years, HMR has seen a marked increase in the number of ALS cases. Improving the care and services available to patients and their loved ones called for a specially designed meeting space. With the support of the HMR Foundation, medical staff received special upgrade training. Furthermore, the hospital acquired furniture and equipment designed specifically to meet these patients' needs. The clinic acquired a range of devices including one to measure respiratory strength and a folding scale for patients using a wheelchair.

Since 2013, HMR's medical staff has spared no effort or ingenuity in order to better meet these patients' needs. Evaluation tools, information leaflets, interdisciplinary working groups and patient support meetings were all introduced. In 2015, the teaching clinic was set up to add to the various projects implemented to improve care.

5 YEARS OF COMMITMENT TO RESEARCH

The HMR Foundation believes strongly in sharing knowledge, expertise and teaching excellence at HMR.



In 2015, HMR's and the HMR Foundation's Council of Physicians, Dentists and Pharmacists (CPDP) Fellowship Program turned five. Aimed primarily at medical residents, the Program seeks not only to support recipients during their subspecialization training, but also to recruit the cream of the crop to practice at HMR. Thanks to these fellowships, future physicians can get solid training and return to HMR with their newly acquired expertise, which is often unique in Quebec. After all, it's no secret that having the top physicians means being able to deliver the best patient care.

HMR nephrologist Dr. Louis-Philippe Laurin is a prime example of this idea.

In 2011, he received a grant that provided the financial leverage he needed to undergo complementary training at a highly specialized learning institution in the United States. There, he honed his knowledge in a leading-edge field of his area of expertise, glomerular diseases. Today, thanks to the training he received, he is able to conduct research and convey his knowledge to residents, while advising other doctors on the best treatments for their patients.

GRATEFUL ANATOMOPATHOLOGY RESIDENTS

In 2015, the Foundation funded the **enhancement of the Anatomopathology Department's classroom** to the tune of **\$60,000**.

Pathologists play a crucial role in diagnosing disease. Using tissue samples taken from patients, they can identify a medical condition and even its severity. Given that most of their work is done using a microscope, the quality of the optics and ergonomics has to be of highest quality. As the following testimonials demonstrate, the Foundation's support has had a marked impact on residents' learning.

"The department acquired a microscope with a co-observation head that allows me to see what's under the microscope at the same time as the lead physician. What's more, a camera was affixed to the microscope to project high-definition images onto a screen. This allows pathologists to explain and demonstrate the reasoning behind their diagnosis for the benefit of a number of residents at the same time."

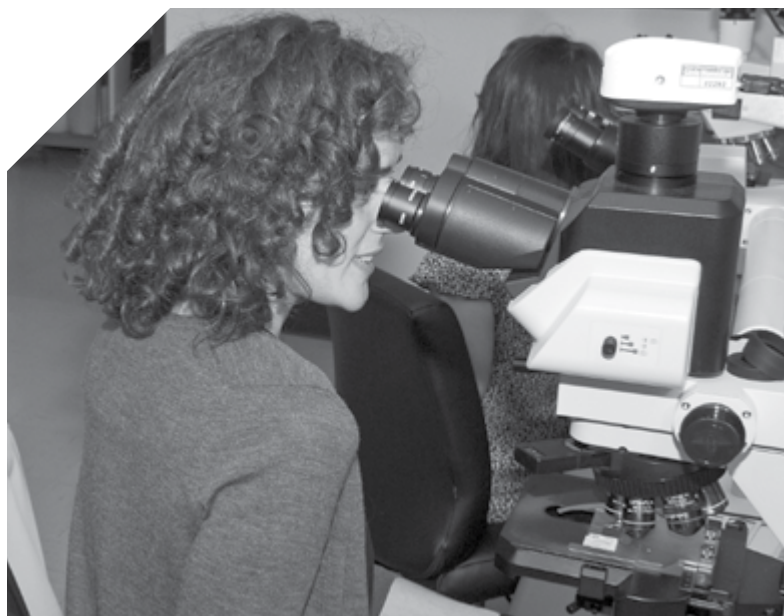

THE CHARRON FAMILY

Over the past 30 years, the Charron family has required a great deal of orthopedic care: their mother, Louise Charron, had four hip replacements, each at a different hospital. Five years ago, they heard great things about the HMR Orthopedics Department and got first-hand experience of the team's expertise and great skill.

The dedication of the members of the arthroplasty unit enables HMR to provide care of exceptional quality that serves as a model for this field in Quebec. *"Our family wanted to support this sector's development, in particular the work of doctors Martin Lavigne, Pascal-André Vendittoli, Vincent Massé and their colleagues."*

Since 2012, the Charron family has contributed regularly to the HMR Foundation in order to support the growth of orthopedic care and research. *"We have developed a great interest in research projects that will help or already are helping improve surgical intervention methods in the orthopedics field, especially with respect to hip replacements."*

Among other things, their support has led to the acquisition in 2014 of a radiostereometry analysis device, a state-of-the-art instrument that improves follow-up for patients who have undergone knee or hip replacement surgery.

A number of projects underway are seeking to improve post-operative analgesia approaches, various skin incisions and new implants that foster a prompter return to normal activities. Furthermore, new minimally invasive surgical techniques are being developed that will lead to more effective patient rehabilitation. *"It is with great pleasure that we wish to associate the family of Louise and André Charron with the excellence of the great institution that is HMR for years to come."*

RESEARCH CENTRE CYCLING CHALLENGE

For the fourth consecutive year, the employees of the HMR Research Centre gave their time to organize the Défi Vélo – Roulons pour la thérapie cellulaire cycling challenge.

On September 12, 2015, 63 cycling enthusiasts accepted the challenge launched by the team at the Research Centre. In addition to the thousands of kilometres they rode together, they raised \$48,590 to support cellular therapy research.

The funds will go toward recruiting young researchers, awarding excellence grants, improving current treatments and purchasing state-of-the-art equipment, all in the name of developing innovative treatments to improve public health.

For the Research Centre team, Mai Duong was the perfect spokesperson to represent its benefit event. An energetic young mother, Mai Duong was 32 when the doctors at HMR diagnosed her with acute myeloid leukemia. After suffering a relapse in 2014, she was able to benefit from an umbilical cord stem cell transplant.

Today, she's in remission and is very grateful to her medical team. More than anything, she wants to support cellular therapy, the medicine of tomorrow saving lives today. She also wants to support all the other patients who, like her, will receive devastating diagnoses.
